NOTICE hereby is given on the following matters:

1. GSA Electrical Power Shutdown at the Powell U.S. Courthouse and Annex Complex – ECF Impact

The General Services Administration (GSA) has advised the judiciary that all electrical power to the Powell U.S. Courthouse and Annex complex, at Richmond, Virginia, will be turned off during the evening of Friday, June 22, 2001 (commencing at about 7:00 p.m.), through and including Sunday, June 24, 2001. The power shutdown is necessary to permit the undertaking of required maintenance by the GSA at both facilities. Since there will be no electrical power available to operate the ECF server equipment over the weekend of June 22-24, access to ECF data and the ability to file over the Internet in ECF cases (including new petitions and schedules) will not be possible. The GSA advises that electrical power will be restored at both facilities by Monday, June 25, 2001, by 8:00 a.m..

2. Entry by the Court of Standing Order No. 01-5 (Order Adopting Electronic Case Filing Procedures)

The Court has entered Standing Order No. 01-5 (Order Adopting Electronic Case Filing Procedures). This standing order, which rescinds Standing Order 99-1 and makes changes to the Exhibit to that order, became effective on May 31, 2001. With respect to the Exhibit to Standing Order No. 01-5, changes have been made to the following provisions: Subparagraphs I.C.1, 2 and 5; II.A.1(a) and (b); and D.1. Changes also have been made to Paragraphs II.E. and IV.A. In addition, changes have been made to the Notice of Electronic Filing Procedure form. Lastly, the recently revised Electronic Case Filing System Attorney Registration Form has been incorporated into the Exhibit to Standing Order No. 01-5. This standing order has been substituted for the rescinded Standing Order 99-1 and is posted on the Court's Internet (under "Local Rules") and CM/ECF (under "Electronic Standing Orders," "Getting Started" and "CM/ECF Admin. Order") home pages.
