**SPECIFIED PETITION FILING FEES PRESCRIBED BY THE BANKRUPTCY ABUSE
PREVENTION AND CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT OF 2005 AND
EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT FOR DEFENSE, THE GLOBAL
WAR ON TERROR, AND TSUNAMI RELIEF, 2005**

EFFECTIVE MONDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2005

The Administrative Office has issued guidance to the courts on the effective date of the changes to specified petition filing fees prescribed by the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act (BAPCPA) of 2005 (Pub.L. 109-8, 2005) and the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Tsunami Relief (Emergency Supplemental Act), 2005 (Pub.L. 109-13, 2005). The Emergency Supplemental Act corrected a drafting error contained in Pub.L. 109-8.

Accordingly, effective Monday, October 17, 2005, the specified petition filing fee amounts required by 28 U.S.C. §1930 will change as follows:

Chapter 7	Increase from \$209 to \$274 Under BAPCPA & Emergency Supplemental Act	Changed Fee Includes \$39 Administrative Fee & \$15 Trustee Surcharge
Chapter 11 <i>(Non-Railroad)</i>	Increase from \$839 to \$1,039 Under BAPCPA and Emergency Supplemental Act	Changed Fee Includes \$39 Administrative Fee
Chapter 13	Decrease from \$194 to \$189 Under BAPCPA and Emergency Supplemental Act	Changed Fee Includes \$39 Administrative Fee
