	ORDER	

Since the onset of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia (the "District Court") has imposed entry requirements for the facilities where it is resident to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. The District Court has updated its entry requirements from time to time in response to developing guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and state health authorities regarding the spread of COVID-19 and evolving community conditions. The District Court and the United States Bankruptcy Court share common divisional courthouse facilities in the Eastern District of Virginia except in the Alexandria Division. Accordingly, the Court must address separately the policy for operations in the Martin V.B. Bostetter, Jr. United States Courthouse in the Alexandria Division (the "Bostetter Courthouse").

In reliance upon the sound judgment of the District Court and in the interest of employing a consistent districtwide policy, the Court finds that it should adopt for the Bostetter Courthouse any COVID-19-related entry requirements imposed by the District Court for its facilities.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that, effective immediately, the Court hereby adopts for the Bostetter Courthouse any COVID-19-related entry requirements imposed by the District Court for the facilities where it is resident, both as currently in effect and as may be modified by the District Court in the future, without need for further order. It is further ORDERED that if the District

Court repeals its COVID-19 entry requirements entirely in the future, then such requirements will be likewise repealed for the Bostetter Courthouse without need for further order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
