## REDESIGNED COURT INTERNET WEBSITE; UPDATED LINK-RELATED INFORMATION TO THE COURT'S NEW BANKRUPTCY NEXT GENERATION CASE MANAGEMENT/ELECTRONIC CASE FILES WEB PAGE—COMING IMPLEMENTATION ON MARCH 21, 2022; MANDATORY NEW CM/ECF LOGIN PROCEDURES

The Court recently implemented a redesigned internet website. While the URL address for that website remains the same, it was necessary to rename links to that site. This includes the Court's new Bankruptcy Next Generation (NextGen) Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) System's web page. As set forth in the Court's November 2, 2021, Announcement, on March 21, 2022, the Court will migrate its current CM/ECF System to the Bankruptcy NextGen CM/ECF System. New NextGen CM/ECF login procedures are mandatory. Please click on the Court's internet website's CM/ECF NextGen is Coming March 21, 2022, web page to access this *very important* information. Timely following the instructions set forth on that web page will enable you to continue e-filing in ECF with the Court when the new system is implemented. This migration will provide you with the benefit of new Central Sign-on functionality and the ability to maintain one account across all NextGen courts (appellate, district, and bankruptcy). You only will need to sign in once, using your one login name and password, to access any NextGen court in which you have e-filing permission. As a user, you must have an individual PACER Account, which will be your entry login point for both PACER and CM/ECF. Courts continue to be responsible for admitting attorneys and assigning e-filing permissions, and each court will continue to identify each user's appropriate access level.
