ORDER CONCERNING EXCEPTION TO STANDING ORDER 20-12 FOR CHAPTER 11 CASES IN THE RICHMOND DIVISION ONLY

On March 31, 2020, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia entered a Second Order Temporarily Extending All Deadlines in Bankruptcy Cases ("Standing Order 20-12"). Pursuant to paragraph 4 of Standing Order 20-12, "[t]he provisions of this Order shall control with respect to all cases currently pending and cases to be filed in this Court, unless the presiding judge otherwise orders in a particular case." In light of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that Standing Order 20-12 shall not apply to cases under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") or to any adversary proceedings within such cases in such cases currently pending in the Richmond Division; and it is further

ORDERED that Standing Order 20-12 shall not apply to cases under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code filed in or transferred to the Richmond Division during the Extension Period (as such term is defined in Standing Order 20-12) or to any adversary proceedings within such cases; and it is

ORDERED that nothing herein shall prejudice the rights of any party to file a motion requesting any other case or matter pending or to be filed in the Richmond Division be excepted from Standing Order 20-12; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall post this General Order on the Court's website and distribute a copy to all registered CM/ECF users by email.
