ENSURING PUBLIC ACCESS TO COURT RECORDS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Access to the Court's public computer terminals is not currently available due to the closing of public areas in the Eastern District of Virginia courthouses due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. That pandemic has significantly restricted public access to automated court records, via each affected courthouse's Public Access to Court Records ("PACER") computer terminals. See Standing Order No. 20-10. You may register to secure an account with PACER by accessing PACER.gov. Subject to the volume of records accessed, creation and usage of a PACER account may be without cost since no fee is owed for electronic access to court data. via PACER, until an account holder accrues charges of more than \$30.00 in a quarterly billing cycle.

Alternatively, if you cannot access PACER.gov and cannot afford to pay for copies of electronic Court records, please telephonically contact the appropriate division of the Court using the list set forth in the above-referenced Notice to Public Access Terminal Users. Also, as set forth therein, such records are restricted to your own personal, non-commercial use.
