**UPDATE ON CASE MANAGEMENT/ELECTRONIC CASE FILES (CM/ECF)  
SYSTEM UPGRADE FROM BANKRUPTCY CM/ECF RELEASE 3.1.7 TO  
RELEASE 3.2**

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

In a September 30, 2008, Public Notice, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia advised that it intended to upgrade its CM/ECF System to Bankruptcy Release 3.2 (Release 3.2) later this fall. Since then, however, the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (Administrative Office) has reported that a number of courts are experiencing performance-related issues with Release 3.2. For this reason, the Administrative Office is recommending that those courts that have not yet upgraded to Release 3.2 consider not upgrading until these issues have been resolved.

The Administrative Office further has advised that it is treating this as a high national priority matter and that it is committing considerable resources to resolve all outstanding performance-related issues. External users of the Bankruptcy CM/ECF System are encouraged to continue reviewing the Release 3.2-related information links embedded in the above referenced September 30, 2008, Public Notice. The Court regrets the need to defer its upgrade to Release 3.2 but feels that it is prudent to do so in light of the circumstances set forth herein. Further notice will be provided when the Court's upgrade to Release 3.2 has been scheduled.
