1. Access to CM/ECF, PACER-Net, BOPS, CHAP, and McVCIS

Access to CM/ECF, PACER-Net, BOPS, CHAP, and McVCIS will not be available commencing at 5:00 P.M., Friday, April 19, 2013. Access is expected to be restored at or about 8:30 A.M., Monday, April 22, 2013. The Court's Bankruptcy CM/ECF System will be upgraded from Bankruptcy CM/ECF 4.3 through Release 5.0 to Release 5.1. Periodically check for restored access over the weekend.

2. CM/ECF On-Line Training Materials and CM/ECF Electronic Learning Module (ELM)

This upgrade includes a number of new features and functional enhancements. To assist external users in preparing for the upgrade, the CM/ECF Training Materials Page has been updated.
