


Due to many instances in adversary proceedings where the complaint has not been properly served or a properly executed certificate of service filed prior to convening the initial pretrial conference, effective immediately, the Court will not convene a pretrial conference in any adversary proceeding unless and until (1) the complaint has been properly served on all parties, and (2) a properly completed and executed certificate of service reflecting proper service on all defendant parties has been filed in the adversary proceeding.
