ORDER REGARDING DEBTORS' MOTION TO RECONSIDER
ORDER APPOINTING *AMICUS CURIAE*

This case was before the court on the debtors' motion to reconsider the court's order appointing an *amicus curiae*. (Docket Entries 575 and 563, respectively). The court granted the United States Trustee's Motion to Appoint an Examiner which effectively supercedes the court's order appointing an *amicus curiae*. The United States Trustee appointed Stephen E. Leach as examiner. The court had previously appointed him as *amicus curiae*. Upon consideration of which and for the reasons stated on the record, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Memorandum Opinion and Order Appointing *Amicus Curiae* (Docket Entry 563) is superceded by the appointment of Stephen E. Leach as examiner. Mr. Leach shall act only as examiner from and after his appointment as such.

2. The provisions of the order appointing Mr. Leach *amicus curiae* relating to his fees and expenses are continued in force. He may apply for any fees and expenses incurred while acting as *amicus curiae* in his fee application as examiner. He will, however, separately identify the fees for such time and effort.

3. The court may issue a memorandum opinion relating to these matters at a later date.
