IMPENDING CHANGES TO OFFICIAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS AND DIRECTOR'S
PROCEDURAL FORMS EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2015

Effective December 1, 2015, most of the current official bankruptcy forms will be replaced by new forms. These forms are renumbered, reformatted, and substantially revised. The Judicial Conference of the United States has approved revisions to the following Official Bankruptcy Forms: 1, 2, 3A, 3B, 4, 5, 6Sum, 6A-J and declaration, 7, 8, 9A-1, 10, 10A, 10S-1, 10S-2, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16A, 16B, 16D, 17A-C, 18, 19, 21, 22A-1, 22A-1Supp, 22A-2, 22B, 22C-1, 22C-2, 23, 24, 27, and the abrogation of official Forms 11A and 11B. These new forms shall govern in all proceedings in bankruptcy cases commenced on December 1, 2015, thereafter commenced, and insofar as just and practicable, all proceedings then pending. Some of the modernized forms already are in effect and will be renumbered. The following six forms will be revised in 2016 or later: 20A, 20B, 25A, 25B, 25C, and 26.

Effective December 1, 2015, virtually all of the directors procedural bankruptcy forms (current forms 13S through 283) also will be replaced by updated and renumbered versions.
