BANKRUPTCY CASES IN WHICH A CREDITOR FILES A RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF
FINAL CURE PAYMENT INDICATING POSTPETITION AMOUNTS ARE DUE

Effective immediately, as set forth in Norfolk Standing Order No. 16-1 – Newport News Standing Order No. 16-1, dated January 6, 2016, and applicable to the Norfolk and Newport News divisions, “upon the filing of a Response to Notice of Final Cure Payment under Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002.1, indicating that the Creditor ‘[d]isagrees that the Debtor(s) is current with respect to all payments consistent with § 1322(b)(45),’ and is owed unpaid postpetition amounts as set forth therein, the Standing Chapter 13 Trustee shall set the matter for hearing in the ordinary course.”
