**BANKRUPTCY OFFICIAL FORMS, COMMITTEE NOTE, AND INDIVIDUAL
DEBTOR INSTRUCTIONS CHANGES RESULTING FROM ENACTMENT INTO LAW
OF THE HONORING AMERICAN VETERANS IN EXTREME NEED ACT OF 2019
(HAVEN ACT)**

The Honoring American Veterans in Extreme Need Act of 2019 (the [HAVEN Act](#), Pub. L. No. 116-52) was signed into law by the President on August 23, 2019. Section 2 of the HAVEN Act amended 11 U.S.C. § 101(10A) to exclude from the definition of Current Monthly Income certain payments made “under title 10, 37, or 38 of the United States Code in connection with a disability, combat-related injury or disability, or death of a member of the uniformed services.”

The Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules has made minor changes to several forms, a Committee Note, and Individual Debtor Instructions, which conform to the applicable provisions set forth in the HAVEN Act, and which are accessible at uscourts.gov on that internet web site’s [Pending Changes in the Bankruptcy Forms](#) page.
