ORDER ADOPTING COURT ELECTRONIC NOTICING PROCEDURES


THIS MATTER arises *sua sponte* upon the need for the Court to announce its procedures for obtaining notices electronically. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9036 – Notice by Electronic Transmission, the Court may direct notice by electronic transmission if the entity entitled to receive the bankruptcy notice requests in writing that the notice be transmitted electronically. The written requirement is fulfilled through an electronic noticing agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Court will provide electronic noticing agreements through the judiciary’s Bankruptcy Noticing Center to any entity requesting this service.
2. The terms and procedures for electronic noticing are detailed in the Court’s noticing agreement provided by the Bankruptcy Noticing Center.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date in which the Clerk of the Court advises the Court that the Bankruptcy Noticing Center has scheduled the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia to

participate in the aforesaid electronic noticing agreement procedures
process.


