**ORDER CONCERNING CONTINUED BANKRUPTCY COURT
OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES CREATED
BY THE OUTBREAK OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)
FOR THE RICHMOND DIVISION ONLY**

Richmond Division General Order 20-2, entered on March 20, 2020, implemented the Protocol in Response to Public Health Emergency (the “Protocol”) on an interim emergency basis effective March 23, 2020 through and including April 30, 2020. The Protocol provides that it may be amended by further Standing Order. In light of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED the Protocol shall be effective and apply to all bankruptcy cases and proceedings through and including May 31, 2020. Except as modified herein or by any subsequent order of the Court, the Protocol, as attached to Richmond General Order 20-2, shall remain in full force and effect; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall post this Order on the Court’s website and distribute a copy to all registered CM/ECF users by email.
